

Explore Sri Lanka

9 Nights/ 10 Days
01 May – 31 October 2016

Day 01: On arrival you will be met by the chauffeur guide and transferred to Colombo. Approximate travel time 1 hour. Evening: City tour of Colombo including the visits to the Commercial, Residential and Bazaar areas. Back to the hotel and overnight in Colombo.

Day 2: Proceed to Habarana. En route visit the Elephant Orphanage at Pinnawala. This orphanage is the home for about 60 elephants, out of which some are baby elephants found, abandoned or orphaned in the wild. They are being cared, fed and trained by the wild life authorities. The best time to visit is during the feeding times, when one will have the opportunity of seeing the baby elephants being bottle-fed. Also could accompany the elephants to a river close by and see them having their daily bath. Approximate travel time 2.5 hours to Pinnawala and 3 hours to Habarana. Arrival to the hotel and check in. Habarana the central point of Sri Lanka's cultural triangle and the most convenient base for excursions to the Ancient historical cities. Evening will be spent at leisure. Overnight stay in Habarana.

Day 03: Breakfast – Free day at leisure and time for optional tours
Optional: Excursion to Sigiriya Rock Fortress. A world heritage site, a spectacular Rock Fortress one of Sri Lanka's major attractions.
Optional: Afternoon jeep safari of the Minneriya National Park which is famous for its migrant heard of wild Elephants. Payment can be made direct on site.
Overnight stay in Habarana.

Day 04: After breakfast, leave for Kandy visiting a spice garden to see spices growing in their natural habitat and learn about spices and their use in Sri Lankan cuisine. Approximate travel time 2.5 hours to Kandy.
Kandy: This lovely city is the Hill Capital of Sri Lanka and was the last stronghold of the Sinhala Kings. It still retains an aura of grandeur which has been unaffected by time. Encircled by hills, with a tranquil lake in its center, it is the site of the renowned "Temple of the Tooth" and the Royal Botanical Gardens - home to one of Asia's best Orchid collections. Kandy and its satellite villages are the center of the island's handicraft industry and its traditional dances are the most lively and spectacular in the country.
The afternoon will be spent sightseeing Kandy including Arts & Crafts workshop, Oriental Market Place, Bazaar and Gem Lapidary. Overnight stay in Kandy.

Day 05: Visit the Royal Botanical Garden after breakfast. The Botanical Gardens is 147 acres in extent, stated in 1374 as a pleasure garden of the Kings of Kandy. There are more than 5000 species of tree and plants as well as some rare and endemic flora from the tropical world. Spice Garden and Orchid House are popular with tourists. This is haven not only for Scientists but to every nature lover as well. Overnight stay in Kandy.

Day 06: Leave to Nuwara Eliya after breakfast visiting a tea plantation to see how tea is plucked and a factory to witness the processing of the raw green leaf to the final graded product. (Approximate travel time 2 hours to Nuwara Eliya)
Nuwara Eliya – Sri Lanka's premier hill resort with a fine bracing mountain climate, Nuwara Eliya is also the heart of Sri Lanka's tea country, producing some of the world's best tea. The mountain slopes and valleys are a carpet of velvety green tea plantations, interspersed with gushing streams and tumbling waterfalls. Red or green roofed plantation bungalows, English country style homes and hotels with lovely flower gardens, a fine 18-hole golf course and a racecourse gives Nuwara Eliya a decidedly British character. Overnight stay in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 7: Leave early morning for a jeep safari of the Yala National Park. Situated 309 km south of Colombo, Yala is approximately 1259 km in extent and is located in the south eastern corner of the Island. It is popular for Elephant, Leopard, bear, Crocodile and Wild Boar. It is the second largest National Park in Sri Lanka. Its open undulating terrain made it famous for elephants for many year, but recently the park has also received much fame through publicity by National Geographic and the Discovery Chanel, which focused on a leopard research conservation and identification project. In addition to a heavy concentration of leopards and and birds. Evening at leisure to explore the surroundings. Overnight stay in Yala.

Day 08: Proceed to Bentota Beruwela after breakfast via Galle visiting the Dutch Fort and Museum stilt in Weligama, the mask manufacturers in Ambalangoda and a turtle hatchery in Kosgodra. Approximate travel time is 4-5 hours to Bentota Beruwela. Full day at leisure.

Day 09: Breakfast. Full day at leisure.

Day 10: Breakfast – Transfer to the Bandaranaike International Airport in time to meet departure flight. (Approximate travel time 3 hours to airport).
